

Cornerstone Press is looking for book-length manuscripts. If you have a book-length manuscript in any genre (e.g. non-fiction, fiction, poetry, children's literature, graphic novel, artist's book), you should consider publishing it with Cornerstone Press at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point (UWSP). Send your manuscript by January 15, 2012 and you could be Cornerstone Press's next author!

Cornerstone Press has published 30 books to date, including the first edition of *Wildflowers of Wisconsin and the Upper Midwest* (the second edition was published by the University of Wisconsin Press) and *Influences: How Ancient Hinduism Dramatically Changed Early Christianity* (an edition of which was published in India in 2009). The most recent publication to emerge from Cornerstone Press is *Whipped, Not Beaten*, a chick-lit novel written by UWSP alum Melissa Westemeier.

Cornerstone Press is staffed by students enrolled in UWSP's upper-level Editing and Publishing course. This spring, Cornerstone Press will once again publish one or more books. Students enrolled in the Editing and Publishing course will be responsible for selecting the manuscript, editing, designing, printing, binding, marketing, and selling roughly 1,000 copies of the finished work. They also pay the author standard royalties on all copies that they sell.

An additional goal of Cornerstone Press is to actively assist its authors in realizing further opportunities. Cornerstone Press has extended its responsibilities to seeking representation of its titles and authors to other book publishers. If Cornerstone Press, with its relatively limited distribution networks, can sell 1,000 copies of your book, this is an excellent indication to other publishers that you have authored a saleable manuscript, and the Press is more than willing to pass along rights to a second printing/edition of this manuscript and/or assist its authors in achieving a contract for their next work.

When submitting a manuscript for consideration of publication by Cornerstone Press, please include the following items with your submission:

1. A cover letter that tells us who you are (including details of your writing experience, qualifications, and any other information that may be relevant to the manuscript), what your book is about, what form it takes (e.g. young adult fiction, cookbook, collection of essays), and whether there is a market for your book (i.e. potential readership, comparable books)
2. A detailed synopsis of your manuscript, including elements (where relevant) such as a chapter-by-chapter summary, notes on illustrations, etc.
3. A complete manuscript that is typed, double-spaced, includes page numbers, and is printed on one side only

If you would like your manuscript returned to you after it has been reviewed, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for this purpose.
